



7 Point Match (Black - 2, White - 3) Cube at 1. Black to play 33?



The obvious play of making the bar may not be right here. Black's timing in a prime versus prime game is not as good as White's. Another play may get Black better results in the long run. Hitting on the one point with both pieces from the four point (shifting points) and moving to the 21 point is the easy part. The fourth 3 can be moved either 9 to 6 or 13 to 10. It is a toss-up which is better. This move makes White use part of his roll to re-enter and the rest to attack on his 4 point. But if white dances, Black has a great gammon potential with three blots in the outfield. If anyone would like to shed more light on this problem, send your analysis to HBC.
