The double elimination format (DEF), popularly used primarily in the midwest, allows all players losing in the Main Flight a second chance to win first. Currently, for the single player coming out of the second chance to win first place, he must defeat the main flight winner twice and must also have won at least two more matches than the winner of the main flight. Does this seem fair? What do you think? Do you favor the present procedure of the winner of the main flight being guaranteed second place and has to be beaten twice or he is guaranteed second but the Final would be a single match for the championship. Send your preference and reasons why to the Hoosier Backgammon Club and the results will be summarized in next month's newsletter.


## Interesting Positions From the 4th INDIANA CLASSIC


Position #1 - 11 Point Match
