## 1990 Rating Trivia

1. Six players have occupied the top spot in the rating system Wendy, Mick Don, Chuck, Howard and Butch.
2. The six lucky players above are also the only ones to have cracked the 1800 barrier.
3. Wendy has the all-time high rating of 1909 and the only player to break the magic 1900 level.
4. Chuck won the most matches (126).
5. Butch had the most experience points (1684) from 222 matches and also lost the most matches (104).
6. Mick had the highest match winning percentage $(69.9 \%)$. Sorry Larry, maybe you can win over $50 \%$ of your matches this year.
7. The STABILITY AWARD goes to Gabe. His rating only varied 90 points up and down the whole year.
8. The ROLLER COASTER AWARD was won by Don. His rating varied 404 points over the year ( 50 matches minimum).
9. The most improved goes to Don with a gain of 296 points over last year. Ken Bruck finished second (+226) and Mick third with 207 points.

## Lake Tahoe Colossus Event Neil Kazaross vs Mika Lidov 15 Point Match

The HBC Newsletter presents a match from the 1990 Colossus Event at the Lake Tahoe Tournament between Neil Kazaross and Mika Lidov.

Instructions: You will need a backgammon board to follow along. The board is numbered 1 to 24 based on the view of the player on roll. Each player will always be moving from a higher to lower point with only the point(s) moved to used. The home portion of the board is numbered 1-6. Bearing off is noted as moving to the zero " 0 " point. To make it easier to follow, the larger number rolled is noted first. In some situations where the smaller number rolled is forced, it will be presented first. An example: being on the BAR with a roll of 52 with the 5 -point made and the 2 -point open.
Abbreviations used are CB - Closed Board, EF - Entry Failure, NP - No Play Possible, x - opponent's piece was hit, $5^{2}$ - superscribe denotes 2 or more pieces moving to the same point; this example has 2 pieces moving to the 5 point.
In the doubling positions, Neil is the dark checkers and Mika the light checkers and the positions are shown from Neil's side of the board. Study the doubling positions first before going through the games.
