

#### **13 Point Match** (Crawford Game) White - 11 Black - 12 Black to Play 6-2?



As Black, a win on this game will capture the match. If things go downhill, you want to protect against a gammon. At this point, luck has shined on you. After you hit White he danced. What is your play considering that you have 4 blots. This problem was posted to the Internet for comments. Below is one reply...

I'd play 11/5, 15/13. Black continues to compete for the outfield by remaking the 13-point, and provides another builder for the 4- or 3-point. I'm not too worried about the blot on the 21-point because White doesn't have the builders in place to cover the point. White is going to try to escape the checker on the bar, plus the builder on White's 18point, before breaking any other points. My plan is to build my board and force White to leave a blot, while extricating the checkers in White's home board. I'll certainly try to establish the 21-point in favor of the 23-point, but this isn't the roll to accomplish that goal...anonymous.
