"A Very *Mary* Final" 1994 Midwest Championships

If it's spring, it must be time for the **Midwest Backgammon Championships**. Six HBC members, Wendy Kaplan, Mary Ann Meese, Butch Meese, Scott Richardson, Dragan Stevanovic and Larry Strommen traveled to Chicago for the 11th edition of the event. Larry has attended all 11 Midwest Championships.

Scott Richardson was undefeated in the main flight of the overflow Open Division doubleelimination format before losing twice against Ed

Bauder (Peoria, IL) to finish 2nd.

But the BIG win of the weekend belongs to Mary Ann Meese, who won the Advanced Division. Although a strong field, Mary Ann had a slightly easy draw, but that does not mean all the matches were a breeze. In the first round against John Stryker, she trailed 4-8 Crawford in a 9-point match. She kept reminding herself never give up and she triumphed by winning the next 3 games. In round 2, she was down 5-7 when early in the next game, her opponent doubled. She saw this was an easy take and redoubled for the match and on to round 3. Looking back, she considers round 3 victory against Kevin Muench 9-7 Saturday's toughest match. Saturday ended playing for the money against Cliff Mayou. Cliff led 6-3 to 9 when she started her march. She won 3 one-point games and a 4-point game to be guaranteed money. Three or four years ago, she was in the same position winning her first 4 matches. Then, she and her opponent played Saturday evening after a long day and lost. Not this time! She waited until Sunday and, oh, what a difference. In the semifinals, she won 11-0 in 6 games against Marc Gray.

In the 13-point final, Mary Franks led 6-2 after 6 games. From that point, Mary Ann put on her competative face. She won a double-drop, double-gammon, no double-gammon, double-

drop, no double-gammon and Crawford to win 13-6 and her first tournament win since early 1980 in Louisville. Way to go!
